### **MEETING RECORD OF March 1, 2016**

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Peggy Hunka (Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)), Co-Chair of the TGPC POE Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at approximately 9:37 AM CDST. POE Subcommittee members were introduced. The minutes were read by the members and approved.

#### 2. STATUS REPORTS

Recent and Upcoming Outreach Events – AgriLife Extension Water Well Screening Events, Abandoned Water Well Closures, and TGPC Exhibit Booth

The current Outreach Events Status Report (available on the POE Subcommittee webpage, <a href="http://tgpc.texas.gov/tgpc-subcommittees/tgpc-public-outreach-and-education-subcomittee/">http://tgpc.texas.gov/tgpc-subcommittees/tgpc-public-outreach-and-education-subcomittee/</a>, under the "Additional Resources" heading) was reviewed:

  - o Four since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting
  - o None planned through September 2016
- AgriLife Extension Abandoned Water Well Closure Education
  - o None since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting

- TGPC Exhibit Booth
  - National Groundwater Awareness Week Poster at the Capitol had an estimated 1,275 view and the Splash! Into Edwards Aquifer Exhibit had an estimated 458 views. The TGPC Booth at the TCEQ Trade Fair held on May 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> had an estimated 401 visitors.

The Website Demonstration was presented earlier than scheduled on the agenda because Sarah Schlessinger had to leave at 10:00AM. She gave an overview of the information that is available on the Texas Alliance of Groundwater Districts website.

## TWON Training Activities

Diane Boellstorff (AgriLife Extension) reviewed the TWON schedule of completed, confirmed, obligated, and suggested water well one-day training events and workshops. There have been over 6264 samples or attendees at TWON events since April 2011.

# **TGPC** Website Activity Statistics

Peggy Hunka (TCEQ) the Google Analytics activity report on the TGPC website for February 25, 2016 through June 20, 2016. The average website visit duration was 1:53 minutes down almost one minute, and the average pages/visit was down to 1.93 pages/visit from 2.05 in December. Website activity spiked in March probably due to The National Groundwater Awareness Poster, and publication of the Texas Realtor Magazine article in April As usual,

GovDelivery emails regarding the quarterly TGPC meeting also generated a spike in website activity.

TGPC Groundwater Educational Outreach Plan, 2nd Edition

## **Topic Updates**

Three of the four topics in the current *Texas Groundwater Protection Committee Groundwater Educational Outreach Plan* ("Plan",

http://tgpc.texas.gov/POE/TGPC\_POE\_GW\_EduOutreachPlan10Sep2013.pdf) were not discussed at the meeting since there were not representatives present to provide updates. The Texas Well Owner Network updates had been given previously in the meeting.

#### **Publications**

Further discussion on the FAQ for scientific monitoring wells was held. It was decided that adding a statement on the importance of scientific wells to the "What do I Need to Know About Capping a Water Well for Future Use?" was not a good option. Linda Ruiz McCall (Bureau of Economic Geology (BEG)) suggested the title of a new FAQ could be "Why are scientific monitoring wells important and how can I help?" She also suggested that Chris Muller (Texas Water Development Board (TWDB)) write the first draft because the TWDB has a number of these types of wells in place for their water level network.

#### 5. POPULAR PRESS ARTICLES

Peggy Hunka (TCEQ) opened the discussion on the FAQs listed below. All of the FAQs were reviewed at the last meeting and since that time were updated by TWDB to include the 2017 State Water Plan information.

- What is a Regional Water Planning Group (RWPG)?,
- What Planning Activities are Conducted by Regional Water Planning Groups (RWPGs)?,
- What is the Status of the Regional Water Planning Group (RWPG) Process?, and
- What Does It Cost to Conduct Regional Water Planning Group (RWPG) Activities? FAQs Revisions

A motion to approve these FAQs was made by Chris Miller and seconded by Linda Ruiz McCall. The motion carried and the four FAQs were approved for posting on our website.

## 6. DISCUSSION OF CURRENT GROUNDWATER ISSUES

The review of the Texas drought map precipitated a conversation on the need for a flood FAQ. Al Cherepon (TCEQ) mentioned an article in the E-Clips about an oil slick developing after the recent heavy rains. Diane Boellstorff (Texas AgriLife) stated that they were getting questions at their TWON events asking about what to do after a flood. Chris Muller (TWDB) mentioned that they have a group that deals with flood issues. It was decided that everyone would find out what resource are available at their agencies and send that information to Peggy Hunka for distribution to the other committee members for further discussion at the next meeting.
