MEETING RECORD OF NOVEMBER 9, 2006

1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Bruce Lesikar (TCE), Chair of the Texas Groundwater Protection Committee (TGPC) Public Outreach and Education (POE) Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at approximately 10:03 AM CST. POE Subcommittee members and visitors were introduced. There were no concerns with the record of the previous meeting.

2. EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH PLAN

Discuss and Finalize Groundwater Educational Outreach Plan

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the updates in the final draft of the *Groundwater Educational Outreach Plan* from the previous version. Issue A (Urban Landowner Pesticide Application and Groundwater) was discussed at length and slightly revised. Mel Davis (TSSWCB) then proposed, David Gunn (TDLR) seconded, and all POE Subcommittee members voted to approve the final draft of the *Plan*, as amended (based on discussion of Issue A during the meeting), and recommended that it be submitted to the Committee for consideration at their next meeting. TCEQ staff were also given permission to make any additional grammatical changes that may be needed.

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) funding opportunities to support work on some of the Issues in the *Plan* may become available in the early spring of 2007. Potential team members who could work on specific Issues in the *Plan* will be identified at the next POE Subcommittee meeting. The TGPC Agricultural Chemicals Subcommittee may also be able to assist with Issue A.

Identify and Discuss Potential Projects for Fiscal Year 2007

Steve Musick (TCEQ) reported that a contract amendment with Monty Dozier (TCE) has been approved for Fiscal Year 2007 for domestic water well owner outreach, including water well screening events in various parts of the state. Another amendment to this contract is being considered regarding Fact Sheets on drinking water (i.e., hydrocarbons), On-Site Sewage Facilities (OSSF; i.e., homeowner maintenance and graywater usage), and water well capping (vs. plugging). David Gunn (TDLR) offered to participate in the development and review of the latter Fact Sheet.

3. STATUS REPORTS

TGPC Display and Booth – Recent and Upcoming Events

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reported on recent TGPC displays and booths:

Bruce Lesikar (TCE) reported that Monty Dozier (TCE) would be testing their new down-hole camera during the following week.

Steve Box (Environmental Stewardship) wanted to encourage the POE Subcommittee in its mission of public outreach regarding groundwater, its relationship to surface water, and the importance of groundwater to the future of the state. He remarked that the current focus of the *Plan* was on landowners, but that there are others that should also be part of the *Plan's* audience (e.g., pesticide users). For the TGPC display and booth, Steve Box thought that it might be useful to have a broader theme, such as, "Why are these issues important ?" He also suggested having a looping video (e.g., does EPA have any short videos on groundwater ?) or a looping PowerPoint presentation running at the booth.
