## **MEETING RECORD OF SEPTEMBER 19, 2006**

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Bruce Lesikar (TCE) called the meeting to order at approximately 10:08 AM. Texas Groundwater Protection Committee (TGPC) Public Outreach and Education (POE) Subcommittee members and visitors were introduced. There were no concerns with the record of the previous meeting.

#### 2. EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH PLAN

Review Draft Groundwater Educational Outreach Issues A - J

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the draft Plan. Progress has been made on all 10 Issues. During the meeting, each Issue was ranked low, medium, or high in terms of the relative amount of effort anticipated to complete that Issue. Final edits from the group leaders (underlined Issue champions listed below) are due by October 20, 2006. The Educational Outreach Plan will be presented to the Committee at their Second Quarter, Fiscal Year 2007 meeting.

Issue A – Urban Landowner Pesticide Application and Groundwater Lynn Fahlquist (USGS), Michael Hare (TDA), Al Cherepon (TCEQ)

Issue B – New Rural Landowners and Groundwater Wells Lynne Fahlquist (USGS), Mary Ambrose (TCEQ), David Gunn (TDLR)

Issue C – Abandoned Water Well Closure <u>David Gunn</u> (TDLR), TAGD representative

During the discussion of Issue C, Monty Dozier (TCE) reported that they had received their hand-cranked, down-hole camera, with training scheduled for the end of October, 2006. David Gunn (TDLR) indicated that they have 8 mm or VHS tape footage from their down-hole camera and can share their Lessons Learned with TCE.

During the discussion of Issue E, Monty Dozier (TCE) suggested that the Subcommittee investigate the Southern Region Water Quality Planning Information System's FAQ webpages (<u>http://srwqis.tamu.edu/</u>, on the right hand side of the home page, under Hot Topics, click on Drinking Water FAQs) as good examples for potential TGPC FAQ webpages.

During the discussion of Issue J, Leslie Savage (RCT) indicated that she would provide URLs for the first two sub-topics to add as links on the TGPC website. Leslie Savage appreciated the four public comments received on this Issue from the Glasscock Groundwater Conservation District (GCD), Middle Trinity GCD, Mesa UWCD, and Hemphill County UWCD.

Discuss Status of Undeveloped Issues and Whether to Include Them in the Plan

There were no undeveloped Issues to discuss.

Identify and Discuss Potential Projects for Fiscal Year 2007

Steve Musick (TCEQ) distributed an example EPA brochure

(http://www.uwex.edu/farmandhome/wqpaap/pdf/mtbe.pdf) on drinking water and the gasoline additive chemical methyl tertiary-butyl ether (MTBE). Steve Musick is working with Monty Dozier (TCE) on a contract for a Drinking Water Fact Sheet on hydrocarbons (e.g., benzene, benzene toluene ethylbenzene xylene (BTEX), and MTBE) and for On-Site Sewage Facilities (OSSF) Fact Sheets regarding homeowner maintenance and graywater usage.

Topics discussed for potential additional Fact Sheets included nutrients and suspected oil field contamination. The latter topic would cover all of the potential sources that a typical homeowner might encounter and may be incorporated into the hydrocarbon Fact Sheet. A link for the hydrocarbon Fact Sheet could also be provided on the RCT website.

Bruce Lesikar (TCE) reported that the Spanish version of the Radionuclides Fact Sheet is back from the editor and needs to be reviewed. Bruce Lesikar noted that they had received an American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers (ASABE) Blue Ribbon Award for an outstanding entry in the 2006 Educational Aids Competition, in the Publications – Fact Sheets category, for their Perchlorate Fact Sheet.

Abandoned Water Well Closure – Outreach Activities and Effectiveness

Bruce Lesikar (TCE) reported that there may be some abandoned water well closure demonstrations in October 2006, and that this topic was discussed in the Urban Rancher program in Waller County in August 2006 with 15 - 20 participants.
