MEETING RECORD OF JUNE 9, 2015

1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ), Co-Chair of the TGPC POE Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at approximately 1:36 PM CDST. POE Subcommittee members were introduced. There were no concerns with the record of the previous meeting.

2. STATUS REPORTS

Recent and Upcoming Outreach Events – AgriLife Extension Water Well Screening Events, Abandoned Water Well Closures, and TGPC Exhibit Booth

The current Outreach Events Status Report (available on the POE Subcommittee webpage, <u>http://tgpc.state.tx.us/tgpc-subcommittees/tgpc-public-outreach-and-education-subcomittee/</u>, under the "Additional Resources" heading) was reviewed:

- AgriLife Extension Water Well Screening Events
 - Seven since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting (203 samples)
 - None scheduled at this time
- AgriLife Extension Abandoned Water Well Closures
 - None since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting
 - None scheduled at this time
- TGPC Exhibit Booth
 - Four since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting (1,865 estimated attendees)
 - Two planned through August 2015

Photos of the TGPC exhibit booth at the TCEQ Earth Day event on April 22, 2015, and the TCEQ Environmental Trade Fair on May 5 - 6, 2015, were also passed around the table.

TWON Training Activities

Diane Boellstorff (AgriLife Extension) reviewed the TWON schedule of completed, confirmed, obligated, and suggested water well screening events and workshops. There have been over 5,266 samples or attendees at these events since April 2011. Diane Boellstorff also noted that they may work with Bandera County River Authority and Groundwater District on a well closure educational program in early August 2015.

TGPC Website Activity Statistics

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) provided the Google Analytics report on TGPC website activity for January 30 – June 4, 2015. The average website visit duration was almost the same (1.9 vs. 1.8 minutes), but the average pages/visit was again less than what was reported at the last meeting (2.2 vs 3.7). The annual National Groundwater Awareness Week GovDelivery email generated more website activity than the quarterly TGPC meeting GovDelivery email. The TGPC website's internal Search box did not appear to be working and was being investigated. Lynne Fahlquist (USGS) suggested that adding a QR code for the TGPC website to the TGPC's

National Groundwater Awareness Week poster might increase visits. A GovDelivery report indicated that 11% of the TGPC's 5,078 subscribers opened the April quarterly meeting email, and 2% of those clicked the link to the TGPC homepage.

3. SET FUTURE MEETING DATE

The next TGPC POE Subcommittee meeting was scheduled for Thursday, September 10, 2015, at 1:30 PM CDST, in TCEQ's Building F, Conference Room 3202A.

4. PRESENTATION

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed a draft presentation titled "Texas Groundwater Protection Committee and Abandoned Water Wells" to be given at the Industry Council on the Environment (ICE, <u>http://ice-texas.org/</u>) meeting on July 16, 2015. POE Subcommittee members provided feedback which was incorporated into the final presentation.

Chris Moore (RRC) also passed around photos of two large diameter water wells that he had observed in the Austin area.

Draft Texas Groundwater Protection Committee (TCEQ Publication GI-088) Revision

The TGPC trifold brochure, *Texas Groundwater Protection Committee* (TCEQ publication GI-088, <u>https://www.tceq.texas.gov/publications/gi/gi-088.html</u>) is almost 10 years old and TCEQ is running low on hard copies. With the recent establishment of the TGPC Groundwater Issues Subcommittee and the deactivation of four other TGPC Subcommittees, an update and reprint of this publication is required. Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the draft revision, and POE Subcommittee members provided feedback. A final draft would be presented at the next POE Subcommittee meeting.
