# **MEETING RECORD OF SEPTEMBER 10, 2013**

# 1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ), Co-Chair of the TGPC POE Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at approximately 1:40 PM CST and recognized it as being national Protect Your Groundwater Day. POE Subcommittee members were introduced. There were no concerns with the record of the previous meeting.

# 2. STATUS REPORTS

Recent and Upcoming Outreach Events – AgriLife Extension Water Well Screening Events, Abandoned Water Well Closures, and TGPC Exhibit Booth

The current Outreach Events Status Report (available on the POE Subcommittee webpage, <u>http://www.tgpc.state.tx.us/subcommittees-POE-POE.php</u>, under "Additional Resources") was reviewed:

- AgriLife Extension Water Well Screening Events
  - Two since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting (44 samples)
  - Four planned through November 2013
- AgriLife Extension Abandoned Water Well Closures
  - None since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting
  - o None scheduled at this time
- TGPC Exhibit Booth
  - Two since the previous POE Subcommittee meeting (118 estimated attendees)
  - o Three planned through December 2013

**TWON Training Activities** 

Drew Gholson (AgriLife Extension) reviewed the TWON schedule of completed, confirmed, obligated, and suggested water well screening events and workshops. There have been over 2,767 samples or attendees at these events since April 2011.

**TGPC** Website Activity Statistics

The Google Analytics activity report on the TGPC website for June 10 – September 4, 2013 was reviewed by the POE Subcommittee. The average website visit duration was just over two minutes, and the average pages per visit were just over four. Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) noted that some additional enhancements would be made to the TGPC website in Fiscal Year (FY) 2014.

#### **TWON Fact Sheets**

Diane Boellstorff (AgriLife Extension) thanked POE Subcommittee members for their feedback on the draft TWON *Improving Hazardous Materials Management to Protect Groundwater Quality* fact sheet. Diane Boellstorff also reported that a draft fact sheet related to Petroleum Storage Tanks (PSTs) and two draft fact sheets related to livestock should be available for POE Subcommittee review soon.

#### What is a Groundwater Conservation District (GCD) ? FAQ update

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the draft *What is a Groundwater Conservation District (GCD) ?* FAQ update. Chris Muller (TWDB) proposed, David Van Dresar (TAGD) seconded, and all remaining POE Subcommittee members approved the FAQ update with the changes discussed at the meeting. #### What Are the Texas Evapotranspiration Networks ? FAQ

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reported that a draft *What Are the Texas Evapotranspiration Networks* ? FAQ should be available at the next POE Subcommittee meeting.

#### Questions About Groundwater Conservation Districts in Texas update

Ron Kaiser (TAMU) provided background information on the development of *Questions About Groundwater Conservation Districts in Texas* (AgriLife Extension publication B-6120, available at <u>http://www.agrilifebookstore.org/Default.asp</u>) and shared some of the hot topics which should be included in the planned update:

- Desired Future Conditions (DFC) process;
- Permit rules (with examples);
- Day and Bragg court cases, and how they relate to takings;
- Water meters;

- Brackish groundwater; and,
- The jurisdiction of GCDs and RRC related to oil and gas operations.

The POE Subcommittee will provide feedback on draft B-6120 updates as they become available.

# 5. DISCUSSION OF CURRENT GROUNDWATER ISSUES

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) thanked Nikki Dictson (TWRI) for notifying her Texas Watershed Coordinator and Texas Riparian Association distribution lists on July 17, 2013 about the TGPC's online FAQs.

The current drought maps were reviewed by the POE Subcommittee. As of September 3, 2013, 96 % of the state was in one of the five drought categories (about the same as at the last POE Subcommittee meeting), but some or likely improvement in drought conditions was forecast in the eastern half of the state through November 2013. As of September 4, 2013, of the 4,656 active community water systems in Texas, 1,158 were affected by drought (either voluntary or mandatory), and 775 of these use groundwater (either exclusively or partially).
