MEETING RECORD OF NOVEMBER 12, 2014

1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ), Co-Chair of the TGPC POE Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at approximately 9:10 AM CST. POE Subcommittee members were introduced. There were no concerns with the record of the previous meeting.

2. STATUS REPORTS

Recent and Upcoming Outreach Events – AgriLife Extension Water Well Screening Events, Abandoned Water Well Closures, and TGPC Exhibit Booth

The current Outreach Events Status Report (available on the POE Subcommittee webpage, <u>http://www.tgpc.state.tx.us/subcommittees-POE-POE.php</u>, under "Additional Resources") was reviewed:

TWON Training Activities

Diane Boellstorff (AgriLife Extension) reviewed the TWON schedule of completed, confirmed, obligated, and suggested water well screening events and workshops. There have been over 4,822 samples or attendees at these events since April 2011. Diane Boellstorff also noted that AgriLife Extension had bentonite to share with Groundwater Conservation Districts (GCDs), the Arroyo Colorado Watershed Protection Plan (WPP) in the Rio Grande Valley, and/or a well plugging demonstration in Grimes County.

TGPC Website Activity Statistics

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) provided the Google Analytics report on TGPC website activity for September 16 – November 9, 2014. The average website visit duration and the average pages per visit were very similar to those presented at the last meeting. A spike of activity on the TGPC website occurred after the last TGPC meeting GovDelivery email notice.

The majority of the meeting was spent reviewing three draft educational groundwater videos, *How Aquifers Work, Groundwater Budget and Availability Models*, and *Using Groundwater Availability Models in Water Planning* presented by Cindy Ridgeway (TWDB). The videos were well received by POE Subcommittee members and constructive feedback was provided. TWDB plans to make the four videos (including *Aquifers in Texas* which had been presented at the POE Subcommittee meeting on March 5, 2014) publicly available next year.
